Munich, 24th of May 2017 – The world's largest logistics trade fair, the transport logistic in Munich, was a complete success for Compass Logistics International. „We were able to welcome company representatives at our stand who are looking for our expertise in international contract and project logistics,“ comments CEO Michael Müller. The transport logistic 2017 registered a record participation: 2,162 exhibitors from 62 countries presented themselves at the world trade fair, an increase of 5.4 percent. The number of visitors rose by 9.5 percent to over 60,726 from 123 countries. The exhibition grew to 115,000 square meters, the nine exhibition halls were fully booked. "Logistics is an important key factor in modern economies and industries" underlined Alexander Dobrindt, Federal Minister for Transport and Digital Infrastructure.
